## **Business Name for the Incorporated UQ Union**

Secretary Greta Simpson requested the members of the Council to explore further on the preferred business name for the Union upon becoming an incorporated entity and discuss at the next meeting.

#### **General Business**

# I, Saumya Jain move that the 2023 UQ Union AGM be moved to December 15<sup>th</sup>

Saumya Jain spoke on the proposed motion saying that the currently scheduled AGM date of Monday December 11<sup>th</sup> is not suitable for the office bearers and because the handover is on the 15<sup>th</sup>, queried as to the intent of moving the AGM date.

Student Rights VP Ryley Calvert highlighted that some of the office bearers will be away on Union business early that week and hence it is advisable to hold the AGM on the 15<sup>th</sup>.

Sian Chadfield mentioned that certain office bearers are currently working on long term projects that will be hampered by the preponement of the AGM and also that the pay of the office bearers is linked to the days at work.

Secretary Greta Simpson mentioned that the initial idea was to hold it earlier considering the 15<sup>th</sup> is a Friday but that if the Council decides to hold it on the 15<sup>th</sup>, it can be rescheduled for the 15<sup>th</sup>.
