

UQU Lawes Club Membership Terms and Conditions

Conditions of Entry

Members

Along with your UQU Lawes Club Membership Card, all members must present one of the following valid government-issued proof of age identification:

- A photo identification card – Proof of age or Australia Post Keypass identity card
- Australian driver license or learner permit
- Foreign driver license
- Passport (from any country)
- Other recognized proof of age cards

Guests

- All guests must be signed in by a UQU Lawes Club member
- All guests must present valid government issued proof of age ID as above
- All guests must leave their ID at the front door and pay \$5 cover charge
- All guests must be approved by the Licensee or manager
- UQU Lawes Club member may bring one guest each night, unless approved by the licensee.

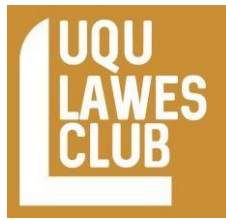
All Patrons

Will be refused entry if:

- They do not have valid government issued proof of age identification
- They are unduly intoxicated and/or are disorderly

Please be aware...

- Unduly intoxicated and disorderly patrons will be asked to leave the premises;
- Footwear must be worn at all times within the venue;
- Liquor is not to be taken from the venue;
- It is against the law to supply liquor to people who are unduly intoxicated, disorderly or under 18.
- Individuals procuring liquor for minors will be removed from the premises and reported to security;
- Persons found fighting in and around the venue will be barred from the venue and details given to UQ Security;
- Anyone causing damages to UQ property will be barred 12 months from the club



Termination

This contract can be terminated at any time if you breach any of the above terms and conditions. If a contract is terminated:

- You will automatically be banned from the UQU Lawes Club for a period of 12 months
- You will be reported to the Lockyer Valley Liquor Action Group, who will enforce a 3 month ban on all license venues in the Lockyer Valley.
- If you live in the Halls of Residence, they will be notified, and this could place your Halls of Residence contract in jeopardy.
- Campus management and UQ security will be notified, and this could also place your position at UQ in jeopardy.
